My step father-in-law left a small, rather simple, map that has the note reading "Where the Kirbys and their friends built their homes when they came from North Carolina to what is now Warren County, Kentucky. Ky. had not been made a state when they came. The houses with a cross by them are first settlers the others are their children." At the top from left to rt. Jesse L. Kirby, L. W. Kirby, Thomas Jefferson Kirby(no crosses). Crosses are by these-Fredrick Potter, Fredrick Poe, John Kirby, George Dye, Johnnie Boone(brother to Daniel), Jesse Kirby, Aaron Couch [Sic Coutts], ? Skaggs, Samuel Kirby, ? Clark, Ratcliff Kirby. None crossed in the body of the map: John Jackson Kirby and Leonard Kirby. Drakes Creek and Trammel Creek run from left to right of the map.

In the lower left is a lake and a stream running to a "Rock Fort". It says: "Three Springs where Daniel Boone, the Kirbys and others built a Rock Fort and Hunted." there are also two other lakes and below one of them it says "These lakes were sunken during the earthquake of 1811."

My father-in-law was John Erskine Beck, son of John Otis Beck and Elizabeth Kirby, grew up in the Bowling Green area.

Jefferson County Ohio Tax List 1816- 1838 , Christian/Christopher Coutts appears on several tax lists beginning 1818. Jefferson County Ohio 1820, Island Creek area he appears as Christian Coutz, 2 males under 10, 1 male 19-16, 2 males 16-26, 1 male 20-45, 1 male 45 & over, 3 females 10-16, 1 female 16-26, 1 female 45 & over. Also there is Jacob Cowtz on the 1830 census for the same county. He appears later as Jacob Coute. And on the 1850 census for the same county is Emanuel Coutts, age 28, a carpenter, wife Nancy A, age 27, Children: John H. age 3, Marinda age 11, Martha age 5, and Jacob age 26, a teacher. Christian Coutts on the Tax List for Springfield Township, Richland County Ohio for the year 1827. This area borders Crawford County Ohio where he lived and died according to the Crawford County History book in my local library. Does anyone have any information on either Jacob or Emanuel? Also There was an Earlier George Coutts in Jefferson County but only the one mention and I could'nt track him. And in 1850 a Melissa Coutts age 18, in the home of widow Elizabeth Campbell age 87, b. Ireland. This is my husband's family and I'm trying to fill in as many details as possible for our children. There is such a Rich history. Thank-you for any help you can give. Sandy
