Needing Descendants of Commodore Perry Coutts born 1819 Bowling Green Warren County Kentucky died 1863 Morgan County Missouri buried in Coutts Cemetery Buffalo Township Morgan County Missouri which is right by the Lake of the Ozarks. He married 3 Aug 1845 Morgan County Missouri to Angeline Catherine Lefever. She was born 1820 Monticello Wayne County Kentucky and died after 1863 Morgan County Mo buried in Coutts Cemetery Buffalo Township Morgan County Mo

In the 1880 census of Morgan County, Missouri Commodore Coutts is living with Wm C. Simmons and his wife Julia Ann (Coutts) Simmons who is his cousin. Both Jesse and Commodore Perry Coutts married sisters, so they are double cousins.

Commodore Coutts is listed as a farm laborer. He died about 1889 in Linn County Kansas. His son Commodore Perry Coutts born 5 Jun 1885 Morgan County Mo Birth Records at Courthouse Versailles Morgan County Missouri Julia Ann (Coutts) Simmons is my 2nd great grandmother. They are buried in the Coutts Cemetery Buffalo Twp. Morgan County Missouri very close to The Lake Of the Ozarks. I hope this helps you. Your Distant Cousin Michael Middleton

Thanks for all the information. My great-great grandfather was Young Allen Moon (b. Aug. 1812 in Oglethorpe(?), Georgia) & Sarah Manly Staples (b. Nov. 1822 in Georgia). Young Allen Moon & Sarah Manly Staples were married Jan. 28, 1840 in Troup Co., Georgia. Their children were Thomas Cornelius; Mary Zephyr; William Henry, M.D.; Jesse David; Jacob Washington; John Edwin (or Ewing); Nancy Jane; Robert Hartsfield; James Allen (my great grandfather & he married Roxie Anna Pruet); Sarah Ann; Carolina A.; & Louisa or Louise (she named her son Young Allen Moon after her father so this proves that Young is a true name & not descriptive). Many of the children resided as adults in Alabama. The children of James Allen Moon (b. ## **BAILEY ANDERSON**

CONTRIBUTED BY MARY BARTON - Anne Miller's copy of guardianship records in Warren Co., KY.

1. Christley and Aaron Coutts, orphans chose, Bailey Anderson as their guardian. They had to be 14 to 21 yrs by law to so "choose". Bailey Anderson, acc. DEED ABSTRACTS, p. 3 of vol.1 in Warren Co., KY, was of Pendleton, Co., SC. The date of the record was 3 Oct. 1797. the witness was Jesse Kirby. QUESTION? Does one suppose a family relationship in such an important choice? Bailey Anderson was the first born son of John Anderson and wife Sarah Carney. His father and two brothers, Scarlett and Joshua died in the Rev War in SC, the father in 1781 and the brothers, of Roebucks's brigade in 1783. Bailey was in the same brigade. The Anderson's with mother and most of the other children moved west to Warren Co., KY, later most settled in Graves Co., KY. Bailey Anderson appears to have gone to Indiana Territory (Warrick Co.) ref. THE DUNN - ANDERSON STORY, by Virginia Dunn Kraut, copyright 1980. The COUTS/ANDERSONS/ BARTONS all originated in VA then NC and SC and KY and IN. Interesting!

## TEXAS STATE HISTORICAL SOCIETY

ANDERSON, BAILEY, JR.

**ANDERSON, BAILEY, JR.** (1788–1865). Bailey Anderson, Jr., soldier and pioneer, the son of Mary (Wyatt?) and Bailey Anderson<sup>qv</sup>, was born on February 25, 1788, in South Carolina. He received a common-school education. In 1795 he and his family moved to Warren County, Kentucky. Anderson enlisted in the War of 1812 on September 11, 1812, at Vincennes, Indiana, as a private in Capt. Thomas Spencer's Fourth Regiment, Indiana Militia. He married Winneford Bozeman of Warren County on January 10, 1814, but she died sometime after the birth of their son. Anderson married Elizabeth McFadden, also of Warren County, on June 4, 1817; they had eight children. The family moved to Arkansas Territory (now Oklahoma) in 1817. By 1821 they had settled in San Augustine County, Texas. Anderson was alcalde of the Ayish Bayou District in the late 1820s. He commanded a company of San Augustine volunteers at the battle of Nacogdoches in 1832 and offered the terms of surrender to Col. José de las Piedras. His most heroic service was at the siege of Béxar in December 1835. With thirty picked men noted for bravery, he captured Colonel Navarro's house in the heart of San Antonio. He moved to Harrison County in 1837 and was appointed a trustee of Marshall University in 1842. Anderson moved to McLennan County in 1853. He died on July 14, 1865.

**ANDERSON, BAILEY, JR.** (1788-1865). Bailey Anderson, Jr., soldier and pioneer, the son of Mary (Wyatt?) and Bailey Anderson, was born on February 25, 1788, in South Carolina. He received a common-school education. In 1795 he and his family moved to Warren County, Kentucky. Anderson enlisted in the War of 1812 on September 11, 1812, at Vincennes, Indiana, as a private in Capt. Thomas Spencer's Fourth Regiment, Indiana Militia. He married Winneford Bozeman of Warren County on January 10, 1814, but she died sometime after the birth of their son. Anderson married Elizabeth McFadden, also of Warren County, on June 4, 1817; they had eight children. The family moved to Arkansas Territory (now Oklahoma) in 1817. By 1821 they had settled in San Augustine County, Texas. Anderson was alcalde of the Ayish Bayou District in the late 1820s. He commanded a company of San Augustine volunteers at the battle of Nacogdoches in 1832 and offered the terms of surrender to Col. José de las Piedras. His most heroic service was at the siege of Béxar in December 1835. With thirty picked men noted for bravery, he captured Colonel Navarro's house in the heart of San Antonio. He moved to Harrison County in 1837 and was appointed a trustee of Marshall University in 1842. Anderson moved to McLennan County in 1853. He died on July 14, 1865. BIBLIOGRAPHY: Nugent E.
